TRINITY'S MISSIONS MOMENTS

An Update from
Pamyla Burrack
 Madrid, Spain

Dear Friends,

Church: After a slow summer the Presbyterian Church of Torrelodones has picked up. Three new families have been attending regularly, with one of those families being non-believers. We have gone from 3 people in the summer to an average of 20-25 on Sunday mornings. Children's Sunday School has grown to 6 children under the age of 5, which makes for a lively time.

When God's work starts moving forward, the enemy is none too pleased. Last spring, Cristina who is a psychologist, was asked to start a Bible study. One of her clients, Paloma, started attending our church sporadically this fall. After attending one of our worship services a month ago, Laloma started calling the pastor and Cristina, making threats against us as a congregation, and particularly against the children. **Please pray that the LORD WOULD HEAL Paloma of this mental illness, and that she would truly draw near to Christ. Pray, too, that He would protect our fledgling congregation, particularly the children.**

Re-Design Team: Much of my time this fall has been spent with work related to the Re-Design team. The nine members of the Re-Design Team will have met this past week in Madrid to analyze and discuss the results of these surveys taken in the last several months. **Please pray that the LORD would give us great wisdom and insight to the plans He has for Europe, and that we would be discerning and follow His lead.**

Future Direction: At the end of August I was asked to consider a position as the Assistant to MTW's International Director for Europe. After weeks in prayer and input from very close friends, I accepted this position for an initial trial period of 6 months. To aid in learning, I will spend two weeks in the MTW offices in Atlanta in December. **Please pray for me as I transition into this exciting position. Pray that I will learn all that I need to learn to be effective in serving our field personnel, for patience with myself as I face this learning curve, and that I would approach each situation I encounter with love and grace towards others.**
