We have just come to the end of our busiest season of the year, culminating in our Asia/Pacific Area Retreat. The past few months have been very full, with David being away from home roughly half of the time over the last four months. We held a Re-entry conference for missionaries who have come home for Home Ministry Assignment, Summer Conference for a similar group of missionaries, Living in Grace for new missionaries preparing for the field, a Child Abuse Awareness and Prevention training in Reynosa, Mexico and the Asia/Pacific Area Retreat. David spent a bit over a week in Malaysia during July making preparations for the retreat, and we both spent time in Charlotte, where Robin's Mom passed away in early August.

It has been a gratifying and humbling experience to host these missionaries for these events. Especially when afterward they tell you that "I have been renewed, refreshed and reminded of my call. I am now ready to go back with joy and enthusiasm."
