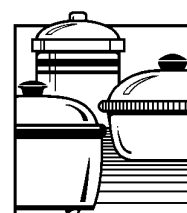

Dear Friends,

I saw Saul and Edgar today and I was glad that they were glad to see me. You see, these are two young men who had left the congregation and seemed to have left the Lord. Both have returned and I want to tell you a bit of Saul's story. Saul was my son Brian's best friend for many years. He encouraged his father to start walking with the Lord and then the whole family got involved in church to some degree or another. Then Saul and his widower dad started fighting. Saul started avoiding church and me, except when he needed money. I told him that I really didn't want to give him money if I didn't see that it was truly helping him. Several months after that he showed up at my door and said he wanted to apologize for letting me down. I assured him that it was his relationship with God that I was concerned about. He then told me that he had joined the Peruvian Commandos. It has been really tough on him and he said they had done everything they could to make him quit, but he just hung in there until done with basic training. At the end of training, their general welcomed them into the force, but then did something very strange. He asked all the new men to raise their hand if they were believers in Christ. Saul and one other raised their hands and the general told them to come and talk with him. He then told them he was a believer as well and that he expected them to be good soldiers of Christ. He took both them to a spiritual retreat at his church and has been encouraging them in that direction ever since.

Isn't God awesome?!

**SCRIPTURE**  
**2 SAMUEL 9 (ESV)**

<sup>1</sup> And David said, "Is there still anyone left of the house of Saul, that I may show him kindness for Jonathan's sake?" <sup>2</sup> Now there was a servant of the house of Saul whose name was Ziba, and they called him to David. And the king said to him, "Are you Ziba?" And he said, "I am your servant." <sup>3</sup> And the king said, "Is there not still someone of the house of Saul, that I may show the kindness of God to him?" Ziba said to the king, "There is still a son of Jonathan; he is crippled in his feet." <sup>4</sup> The king said to him, "Where is he?" And Ziba said to the king, "He is in the house of Machir the son of Ammiel, at Lo-debar." <sup>5</sup> Then King David sent and brought him from the house of Machir the son of Ammiel, at Lo-debar. <sup>6</sup> And Mephibosheth the son of Jonathan, son of Saul, came to David and fell on his face and paid homage. And David said, "Mephibosheth!" And he answered, "Behold, I am your servant." <sup>7</sup> And David said to him, "Do not fear, for I will show you kindness for the sake of your father Jonathan, and I will restore to you all the land of Saul your father, and you shall eat at my table always." <sup>8</sup> And he paid homage and said, "What is your servant, that you should show regard for a dead dog such as I?" <sup>9</sup> Then the king called Ziba, Saul's servant, and said to him, "All that belonged to Saul and to all his house I have given to your master's grandson. <sup>10</sup> And you and your sons and your servants shall till the land for him and shall bring in the produce, that your master's grandson may have bread to eat. But Mephibosheth your master's grandson shall always eat at my table." Now Ziba had fifteen sons and twenty servants. <sup>11</sup> Then Ziba said to the king, "According to all that my lord the king commands his servant, so will your servant do." So Mephibosheth ate at David's table, like one of the king's sons. <sup>12</sup> And Mephibosheth had a young son, whose name was Mica. And all who lived in Ziba's house became Mephibosheth's servants. <sup>13</sup> So Mephibosheth lived in Jerusalem, for he ate always at the king's table. Now he was lame in both his feet.
