TRINITY'S MISSIONS MOMENTS

An Update from
Michael & Julie VrMeer
Southeast Asia

Dear Friends,

We want to share a few milestones from our past few months. November was an unusual month for us as we had multiple visitors from the US come out and stay with us. Michael's sister, Sharon, spent almost 2 weeks with us. We had expected to simply introduce her to our growing family and share with her the "sights and sounds" of Aroma. However, her visit left us with encouraged hearts and a fresh perspective of what the Lord has done.

The end of November brought the arrival of Drs. Ted and Karolyn Cook along with their two teenage children. The Cooks currently practice medicine in the US, but are asking the Lord what He has for them in the coming years as their children move out of the house. Even though our identity here is health education and disease prevention, we decided to treat the poor and sick in two villages by holding a clinic. We were received well in both villages by the local government officials and people alike. We had the opportunity to pray for many of those who were treated. We have a community health program established in one of the villages, and arranged for one of our national church planters to follow up in another. Pray that we will see lasting spiritual fruit in those villages. During their time with us Ted was also able to share at a meeting of doctors in the city. The growing trend of scuba diving in the area and how the medical community can most efficiently handle dive related injuries in our remote environment was discussed. It was a joy to work alongside the Cooks. Please pray the Lord would continue to order their steps and use them to reach the remaining unreached of this world.

Please pray: for a renewed sense of wonder and gratitude for God in sending Jesus, for lasting spiritual fruit in the villages we recently held a clinic in, and for Ted and Karolyn Cook as they seek the Lord's direction for future ministry.

¹ Now in those days, when *the number of* the disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists, because their widows were neglected in the daily distribution. ² Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said, "It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables. ³ Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of *good* reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; ⁴ but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word." ⁵ And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch, ⁶ whom they set before the apostles; and when they had prayed, they laid hands on them. ⁷ Then the word of God spread, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith.

⁴ Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word.

⁵ Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached Christ to them.

⁶ And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. ⁷ For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed. ⁸ And there was great joy in that city.
